

4.2.8 (a) IMD will calibrate, as per frequency mentioned below, the airport meteorological instruments which are used by IMD officials to provide operational aviation meteorological services.

|------|--------------------------------------|--|
| i)   | Wind instruments (direction & speed) | Once in 6 months   |
| ii)  | Transmissometer (for RVR)            | Once in 6 months and prior to commencement of fog season |
| iii) | Temperature/ Dewpoint/Humidity       | Once in a year   |
| iv)  | Pressure                             | Once in a year   |
